# November Presentation – Madison Mailey – Olympic Gold Medal winner – women's eight rowing – Tokyo 2020 (held in 2021)

Madison Mailey gave a very enjoyable and inspiring talk about her journey as a rower – culminating in securing a seat in the women's rowing eight for 2018 and then in the Olympics. Raised on the North Shore, Madison started rowing at Deep Cove and progressed to the junior Canadian team before heading to Northeastern University in Boston where she majored in Management and Entrepreneurship.

Her journey to the Olympics was both an individual feat, but also a remarkable team feat. The crew trained constantly for years honing their physical skills and developing their positive mental skills to deal with whatever challenges sprang up in their way.
